Two weeks ago, some 18 months after making our submission, *WellWishers* were granted DGR [Designated Gift Recipient] status by the Minister for Foreign Affairs and the Assistant Treasurer. This is a very difficult thing to achieve, given we raise money mainly in Australia, for expenditure in a foreign country. *WellWishers* thus have joined an elite number of organisations formally recognised by the government.

What does this means for you, our supporters? Other than now receiving your receipts direct from *WellWishers*, there is no change for you. You can have your receipt sent by post or by email. Please let us know if you would like an email receipt.

We are very excited about our future prospects due to this Commonwealth Government recognition. The new receipting procedure will apply to all donations received from 1 January 2012.

RECORD BREAKING NUMBER OF WELLS FOR 2012

We are very excited to advise that WellWishers will be funding 124 wells next year, 9 more than this year's record. About 40,000 additional people will access clean water.

Like last this year, abnormally high number is the result of continuing prudent management of our financial position, given the volatility of international currency over the past 3 years and the very welcome accumulated currency gains, due to the prolonged strength of the Australian dollar against the US Dollar. However, the current high inflation in Ethiopia may affect WellWishers' level of support in 2013.

Our policy to seek currency value predicitions from at least 3 firms dealing in foreign currency and to take a

suitably conservative approach in formulating our annual wells programme, has served us well. The average prediction made last year for December 2011 was 88¢USD. Currently it is about 105¢, an under-estimate of 19%. Very volatile indeed.

As trustees, we are imcumbent to act prudently and responsibly in the interests of our supporters. I am sure you will agree that this prudence has given us a very pleasing result for this year.

We expect that many scenes such as that above, will be repeated all over the region of Tigray in 2012.

Volunteer Obstetricians & Midwives needed.....

Right now women and children are dying trying to give birth in Ethiopia. There are hospitals and equipment, but not enough people trained in performing caesareans and difficult deliveries.

Dr Andrew Browning, in co-operation with the Ethiopian Health Bureau, is trying to recruit volunteer obstetricians and midwives to help save the lives of these months and babies.
